INTRODUCTION

The Namibia Water Ski Association is excited to host the 2026 All Africa Championships in NAMIBIA for the first time since 2010.

The All-Africa Championship Tournament will consist of four rounds in each discipline starting in the afternoon on Friday, 3rd of April 2026 and ending on Sunday the 5th of April 2026.

Unofficial Practice will take place as of Wednesday afternoon, 1st April 2026.

Official practice will take place on Thursday, 2nd April and Friday morning, 3rd April 2026.

The IWWF Africa Confederation has decided to waive all outstanding fees for its associated and past members. To further ease the financial burden, the fees for the 2025/2026 period will also be waived.

Your federation will soon receive a standard annual invoice showing this change for your records. The IWWF Africa Confederation encourages you to participate in the sport of water-skiing at this African event.

- Jump: N\$ 1600 (4 rounds, normal homologation)
- Three Event: N\$ 3800

PRACTICE SESSIONS

Unofficial practice will be charged at:

- Slalom : N\$ 600 for four passes
- Tricks : N\$ 400 for four passes
- Jump : N\$ 600 for three jumps

Official practice will be charged at:

- Slalom : N\$ 600 for four passes
- Tricks : N\$ 400 for four passes
- Jump : N\$ 600 for three jumps

Practice sessions are only allowed with the homologator's permission. Homologation takes priority over practice

ENTRY FORM AND INDEMNITY

All competitive skiers must enter on EMS (Mini League skiers are excluded). Every skier must fill out an indemnity form before they can ski. More information in next bulletin.

The closing date for entries and payments is 4th March 2026. A penalty of N\$ 1000 will apply for late entries.
